Our school is tucked away in the village of Hauxton, in a large attractive site. We cater for children from ages 4 to 11 years and currently have 75 pupils.

Children spend seven years at Hauxton Primary School moving through mixed aged classrooms; with accommodation in our improved and extended setting further developed in 2017. Our original building has been on the site since 1974.

The central aims of our curriculum are to work in collaboration with families and our extended community to promote pupils' spiritual, moral, social and cultural development and prepare all pupils for the opportunities, responsibilities and experiences of life.
