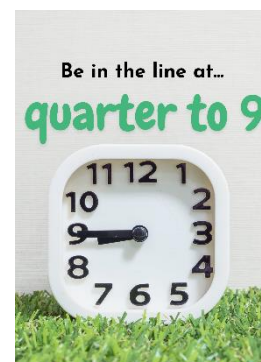

Thank you to those parents who attended our "Meet the Teacher" meetings and took a look around their child's new classroom, we hope that you found it useful. We hope that information which was shared with you, and that is shared on class pages on our school website, will give you a good understanding of the expectations for the class and how you can support your child's learning at home.

As partners, we share the responsibility for our children's success and want you to know that we will do our very best to carry out our responsibilities. We ask that you guide and support your child's learning by ensuring that you:

- Attend school daily and arrive on time, ready for the day's learning experience
- Complete all home learning set by teachers
- Read daily and logs this on BOOM Reader to develop a love for reading and to improve literacy skills
- Let staff know if your child needs additional support in any area



Our school day begins at 8.45am, when classroom doors open. Children can choose to go straight into class or stay and complete our daily mile until 8.55am when classroom doors are locked. After 8.55am, you must accompany your child to the main school entrance so that we are aware that they are in school for fire safety.

School Meals

We encourage all pupils in Willow and our Year 2's to take up the offer of funded school meals. **All meals should be booked in advance using ParentPay** to ensure that our children have their preferred menu choice. Lunches can be booked up to three weeks in advance but **please make sure that bookings are cancelled if they are no longer needed** on a particular day to avoid waste and unnecessary expense.
