We are writing to share an important message about our school meals service. As you may know, school meals are a vital part of our children's day – providing warm, nutritious lunches that fuel learning, play, and growth.

Unfortunately, we are at real risk of losing our onsite cook due to falling uptake. To keep Hauxton cooked school meals available for all our children, we need your support.

Why choose school meals?

- **Balanced nutrition:** Meals are designed to support children's health and development.
- **Variety:** Each week features new menus with options to suit different tastes.
- **Convenience:** No morning lunch-packing hassle!

Whether your child usually brings a packed lunch or has not tried school meals in a while, we encourage you to give it a go. Even one or two days a week can make a big difference.

Don't forget – children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 receive free school meals automatically. If your child is in Years 3-6, you may still be eligible for free meals depending on your circumstances.

Together, we can make sure this valuable service stays in place for all our children. **Please consider booking a school meal this week!**

Federation Consultation

The Governing Boards of Hauxton Primary and Meldreth Primary and Preschool are seeking your views on an important proposal, to federate the two schools under a single governing board starting from 1st September 2025. The consultation period runs from 7th May to 23rd June 2025. The proposal aims to strengthen collaboration and leadership across both schools.

- The final decision will be made independently by each Governing Board.
- Federation will only proceed if **both** Governing Boards vote in favour.
