#### Collection from school

For the purposes of clarity, please note the important points below:

- Children should be collected by their parent or carer (or another named adult approved by the parent), who should be at least 16 years old.
- Y6 children in school are allowed to walk home alone if the parent has given written permission to the class teacher.
- If on any day a different adult is collecting your child, you must inform the school office they will then inform class teachers.
  - If any of the above are not met, your child will be kept in school until we have been able to make contact with you.
- Please note that extra-curricular clubs can be subject to last minute changes so please make sure you pick up messages from school and club leaders regularly. We will always give as much notice as possible.



## **Learning to Swim**

We are incredibly fortunate to have our own pool onsite. Our pupils benefit from dedicated weekly swimming lessons during the summer second half term, helping them to increase their confidence and skills in the wter whilst creating happy memories of having fun with their friends.

Hauxton pool has taught generations of children to swim. It is our mission to ensure we can continue to fund this valuable resource. Pupils swim twice a week over 6 week - compare your donation to the cost of local swimming lessons which cost between £5 - £20 a week.

### Each Year our HSA pay for:

- Comissioning
- **Water testing**
- Electricity for heating
- **Chlorine and supplies**
- Training for pool carers

Costs vary each year but can be up to £4,000
