Important use of Photos Information

As a school, safeguarding our children is at the heart of everything we do. With the increasing use of AI and the potential for photographs to be digitally altered or misused, we have made the decision to take additional steps to protect our pupils.

For photographs shared on the internet accessible by the general public (website), children will now be photographed from behind or from the side, so that their faces are not clearly identifiable. When the newsletter is uploaded to the website, all identifiable images will be removed.

We will continue to share photographs showing children's faces on ClassDojo, as this is a closed platform for our school community. As always, we kindly ask that photographs containing other people's children are not downloaded, shared or posted on social media.
